A TEAM BUSINESS PLAN COMPETITION FOR UCLA STUDENTS TO DEVELOP NEW VENTURES

A TEAM OF UCLA STUDENTS



Two to six members

- At least one member must be an Eligible Law Student:
 - A second-year or a thirdyear student, currently enrolled in UCLA School of Law, in good standing, and eligible to graduate with a J.D. degree, an LLM degree or S.J.D. degree in May 2020 or
 - a graduate of UCLA School of Law who was awarded a J.D. degree, an LLM degree or S.J.D. degree in 2019.

A TEAM OF UCLA STUDENTS



The remaining members must be Eligible UCLA Students:

a person enrolled at UCLA as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student who is in good standing with his or her school at UCLA

Person still eligible even if the person graduates after Dec. 1, 2019.

NEW VENTURES



- New or Existing
- Commercial/For Profit
- Not-for-Profit
- Social Entrepreneurship

- Not venture backed
- Can have funding of family/friends

COMPETITION DATES



Wednesday, October 16, 2019: Registration Opens

 Friday, January 31, 2020: Registration closes

Friday, March 20, 2020:
Business plan due

Monday, April 20, 2020: Public round with oral presentation

COMPETITION



- Form required for registration is available on the website.
- Team members names and contact information.
- Brief statement of proposed venture.
- Representations regarding eligibility at time of registration, at time of submission of the business plan and at time of the public round of competition.

COMPETITION



Required: When you submit your business plan, you must also submit a short video, not more than 2 minutes, explaining your venture.

Optional: You can also submit up to 10 slides with your business plan

COMPETITION RESOURCES



- Mentor assigned to each team
- Class on how to write a persuasive business plan
- Class for law students on the team on how to create a company and other legal tasks for the startup lawyer
